
MECU Sponsors Backpacks For Kids

Watch For ATM **Skimming Devices**

ATM users beware: Look for irregular devices on ATMs you use. Crooks may attach an overlay swipe device, which gleans your name, account number and expiration date off the magnetic strip on the back of your card. Review statements on a regular basis and report transactions you didn't make.
